

## Member Reinstatement Policy

### Non-payment of dues

Annually, on 1 June, each club is required to pay international dues and fees for club members listed on the club's membership list. Failure to pay International dues and fees within 45 days after 1 June or not receiving approval for a temporary waiver, will result in cancellation of membership of each unpaid member

Clubs may reinstate members for non-payment of dues by paying a reinstatement fee plus full-year or half-year dues depending where Zonta International is in the dues cycle.

### Member resignation

Clubs may reinstate members who have resigned while in good standing. Good standing is defined as having no outstanding financial obligations, specifically related to international dues and fees.

Any member who has previously resigned membership must pay a reinstatement fee plus full-year or half-year dues depending where Zonta International is in the dues cycle. Years of membership will be reflected as broken for the period the individual was not a member; however, years of membership will again accumulate once the member has been reinstated and be eligible for recognition.
